# Environmental Management System

## Do

- ✓ Give consideration to neighbours, keep noise down and limited to working hours.
- ✓ Van share where possible.
- ✓ Be aware of protected areas on site (trees, hedges, wildlife).
- ✓ Use appropriate skips – read labels.
- ✓ Put hazardous waste in the separate skips provided, e.g. paint tins, chemicals, oil, tyres, strip lights.
- ✓ Report spills of oil, paint, chemical, dirty water to site staff immediately.
- ✓ Note location of spill kit and how to use it.
- ✓ Comply with your Method Statement precautions when working in areas of contaminated ground.
- ✓ Store materials properly, keep them dry, bundled if necessary and away from vehicles.
- ✓ Ensure spare materials are taken to the next contract.
- ✓ Clean up after yourself.

## Don't

- X Put dirty water down gullies. Use a silt trap if provided.
- X Wash brushes or buckets down sink or drain. Use the wash out area provided.
- X Ignore fresh areas of contamination. Report to the Site Manager immediately.
- X Pour dirty washing water out of buckets on to finished areas of soil or paving. Use the designated area provided.
- X Waste energy or water. Switch off lights, mixers and taps when not in use.
